### **Schedule Distribution**

Schedule distribution is set for August 10, 2017 from 2:00 – 5:00 p.m. All students will need to bring a current copy (**July or August**) of either their **electric or gas bill**. This will need to be the actual bill with the service address and not just the return stub. Students are asked to go to their CHAT teacher's classroom to provide the verification of address (OG&E or ONG bill). Parents will be offered a student insurance packet at this time. Parents will also be asked to fill out the Child Nutrition Form (This form is very helpful to our district and we ask each parent to fill out the information). Finally, the schedule will be distributed.

Students with financial obligations from last year are encouraged to take care of these issues during schedule pick up.

Students who did not pick up their report card from last year are asked to go by the main office to pick it up at this time as well.

### **Blue and Gold Extravaganza**

### **Student Parking**

Sophomore, junior, and senior students who have a valid driver's license and proper insurance coverage are allowed to drive to school. Student parking is assigned to the parking lot east of the main building as well as the area south of the Freshmen Center. Eligible students wishing to drive to school must purchase a parking sticker for \$20. This sticker will be good for one vehicle for the 2017-18 school year. Stickers will be available for purchase during schedule pick up and open house at table in cafeteria area. Once school is in session, stickers can be purchased in the media center from the start of school through the end of August. Beginning in September, all stickers will need to be purchased in the main office. Items needed for purchasing a parking sticker: make, model, and tag # from vehicle; insurance verification; and driver's license.

Freshmen are not allowed to drive to school regardless of age.

### **CHS School Supply Lists**

CHS does not give preliminary school supply lists because the supplies needed are dependent on the courses the student will be taking. Students are encouraged to have notebook paper and a pen/pencil to begin the school year. Teachers will give supply lists which will be necessary for each particular class. Students will be given time to get needed supplies.

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
