## COMMUNITY

Choctaw, Oklahoma, is located immediately east of Oklahoma City. Approximately 12,000 residents enjoy 27 square miles of suburban and rural areas. Choctaw is home to several companies. Racial, ethnic and socio-economic diversity reflects that of the state of Oklahoma.

## SCHOOL

Founded in 1904, Choctaw High School, home of the "Yellowjackets," is one of 9 schools in the Choctaw-Nicoma Park Public School District. CHS is a comprehensive public high school serving grades nine through twelve with an enrollment of approximately 1,650 students. CHS utilizes a Block Schedule with four 90-minute class periods. Professional training is available through the Eastern Oklahoma County Technology Center.

## ACCREDITATION

CHS is accredited through the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Association.
