State of Oklahoma Immunization Requirements

All children entering Kdg. – 12th grade in Oklahoma are required to have:

- 5 doses of **Dap - diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis** + 1 booster 7th -12th;
- 4 doses of **IPV/OPV - polio vaccine** (CDC web site),
- 2 doses of **MMR - measles, mumps, rubella vaccine** (CDC web site);
- 3 doses of **HepB - hepatitis B vaccine** (CDC web site) (Adolescents 11 through 15 years of age can receive a two-dose series);
- 2 doses of **HepA - hepatitis A vaccine** (CDC web site); and
- 1 dose of **varicella (chickenpox) vaccine** (CDC web site).

If you have any questions about your child's shots check with your regular healthcare provider or call the Immunization Service at 405-271-4073.

Also, a booster dose of **Tdap** vaccine is now required for all students entering the 7th and 8th grades. **Tdap** is a combination vaccine that includes pertussis (whooping cough) tetanus and diphtheria vaccines. Tdap is routinely recommended for all pre-teens at 11-12 years of age and all older adolescents who have not yet received a dose.

The Okla. State Department of Health strongly urges parents to consider 2 other vaccines which are recommended for pre-teens at 11-12 years of age:

- HPV (human papillomavirus vaccine) and
- MCV4 (meningococcal vaccine).
